Steerage 3.8%:

Steerage was first brewed as Titanic Best Bitter in 1986. Sit back, relax and enjoy the trip.

BITTER: 6 6 6 6

SWEET:

SEE: Pale Gold

SMELL: Floral, Hoppy, Malty

TASTE: Dry, Fruity, Sweet

MALTS: Maris Otter, Pearl, Wheat, Crystal

HOPS: Pilgrim, Herkules, Northdown, Celeia, Goldings

TASTING NOTE: Gold, refreshing, well-rounded session pale. Soft fruity yet malty aromas with a

slightly sweet taste on the palate.

Iceberg 4.1%:

Brewed first in 1993, this beer has a high percentage of wheat in the grist and was one of the first UK beers to use US hop varieties.

SEE: Pale

MALTS: Maris Otter, Pearl, Wheat

HOPS: Herkules, Cascade

TASTING NOTE: Strong citrus aromas linger while this clean-cut pale ale, with hints of grapefruit,

creates a powerful hoppy finish.

White Star 4.5%:

Originally a super brew of Steerage, now with late and fermenting vessel addition of Summit hops for amazing aroma.

SEE: Pale Gold

MALTS: Maris Otter, Pearl, Wheat, Crystal HOPS: Herkules, Pilgrim, Fuggles, Summit, Celeia

TASTING NOTE: A distinctive golden hoppy yet crisp ale with fruit tastes on the palate and scent.

Stout 4.5%:

We brew flavoured stouts and a keg version, but this is Stout, pure unadulterated stout brewed like stouts should be brewed with roast barley giving colour, body, dryness and depth.

BITTER: **6 6 6 6**

SEE: Black

SMELL: Coffee, Burnt, Roasted TASTE: Dry, Roasted, Smooth MALTS: Maris Otter, Pearl, Wheat,

Roasted Barley

HOPS: Goldings, Northdown, Celeia

TASTING NOTE: Traditional well-balanced dry Stout, roasted smell and taste with definitive hoppy notes.

Plum Porter 4.9%:

If you had suggested our best selling and multi award winning beer would be dark, fruit flavoured and 4.9% three years ago we would have said you were mad! That was before our brewers really understood the dark (fruity) arts!

SEE: Deep Red

SMELL: Plum, Raisin, Fruity
TASTE: Soft, Plum, Vanilla

MALTS: Maris Otter, Pearl, Wheat, Dark Crystal HOPS: Pilgrim, Herkules, Goldings, Celeia

TASTING NOTE: Well-rounded porter with fruity, sweet notes over a backdrop of hoppy flavour.

Deep red in colour but not in taste, the plum lightens the deepness on the palate.
